

# Social Contract - Keeping our Community Safe

Being part of Dragonfly Art Studio means we are each responsible for one another's well-being and for contributing to creating a positive and healthy learning environment.

Dragonfly Art Studio is setting the following guidelines for children, families, and staff. They are based on the current Orders of the Governor, guidelines and applicable licensing requirements from the CDC, New Mexico Department of Health, CYFD, and the New Mexico Early Childhood Education and Care Department ("Current Guidelines").

As a condition for attending Camp, please formally agree that you and members of your household will follow these guidelines to keep your family and our school community as safe as possible:

## Responsible Health Practices

- I will adhere to the current physical distancing, mask and hygiene guidelines in public when on and off campus and avoid unnecessary travel outside Santa Fe when possible. I understand this is the absolute best way to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

## Face Coverings

- I will always wear a face mask when dropping off and picking up my child from camp, or when in contact with anyone at camp.

- I will speak to my child about the importance of wearing a mask while at school and send them to school with a clean face mask every day.

## Personal Health Habits

- I will speak to my child about these safety measures:

-- Washing hands for at least 20 seconds with soap and water before entering camp, before and after using the bathroom, before and after eating, before and after playing outside, and anytime they touch their nose, face or mouth;

-- Catching coughs / sneezes with a tissue and throwing that tissue away. If a tissue is not readily available, one should cough/sneeze into their elbow.

## Illness and Daily Screening

- I will not send my child to school if they or anyone in my family is feeling ill. I understand that students with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher will not be allowed to attend school.

- I will not send my child to school if they or anyone in my family has one or more of the following symptoms not explained by a non-viral cause (like allergies):

-- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

-- Chills

-- Muscle aches

-- Sore throat

-- New loss of taste or smell

- Stomach upset
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Skin Rash

- I will take my child's temperature and complete the Childs Daily Health Screening Form for my child before arriving at camp each school day.

### Communication with School Administration

- I will immediately notify the school if my child, a member of our family, or anyone we have recently come into close contact with, displays any of the above symptoms or has been diagnosed with COVID-19, or has been instructed to quarantine.

- I will communicate any concerns about my own or others' adherence to the Social Contract directly with Administration, with respect and compassion, and always with the assumption of positive intent.

### Travel and Gatherings

- I and people in my household will avoid large social gatherings and unnecessary travel outside of Santa Fe whenever possible.

- I will immediately notify the school if I or anyone in my household has been to an area with widespread community transmission of COVID-19 or traveled out of state within the last 14 days, and I will follow relevant current quarantine guidelines.

### Attendance Decisions

- I will respect and adhere to any decisions made by the Administration regarding my child's attendance.

### Staying Home for High Risk Individuals

- I understand that pursuant to the Current Guidelines, individuals in high risk groups are informed that the safest thing to do is to stay home. Higher-risk groups include people who are older, pregnant, or who have underlying health conditions. Children at high risk, such as those with compromised immune systems or respiratory conditions like severe asthma, should stay home unless they have written clearance from their doctor.

We are grateful for your care, attention and commitment in helping keep the Dragonfly Art Studio community safe and strong. We very much look forward to having your child create art with us. Our ultimate goal is to create a space that is fun and engaging while keeping everyone healthy and safe.
